| Key Vocabulary - Seasons | |
|--------------------------|--|
| Weather | The state of the atmosphere or air in any given place. (Hot, cold, Sunny, windy, Rainy, Snowy.) |
| Daylight | The time of day when the sky is light. |
| Deciduous | A tree that loses its leaves in the Autumn and grows new ones in the Spring. |
| Evergreen | A tree that keeps its leaves all year round. |
| Season | The 4 different parts of the year.(Autumn, Winter, Spring Summer) |



| Key Vocabulary - Plants | |
|-------------------------|--|
| Seed | A seed is the small, hard part of a plant from which a new plant grows . |
| Leaf | Parts of a tree or plant that are flat, thin, and usually green. Many trees and plants lose their leaves in the winter and grow new leaves in the spring. |
| Root | The parts of the plant that grow under the ground. |
| Stem | The stem of a plant is the thin, upright part on which the flowers and leaves grow. |
| Flower | The part of a plant, which is often brightly coloured, grows at the end of a stem , and only survives for a short time. |
| Seedling | A seedling is a young plant that has been grown from a seed. |
| Trunk | The trunk of a tree is the large main stem from which the branches grow. |
| Branch | The branches of a tree are the parts that grow out from its trunk and have leaves, flowers, or fruit growing on them. |
| observe | To watch something carefully and notice changes. |
