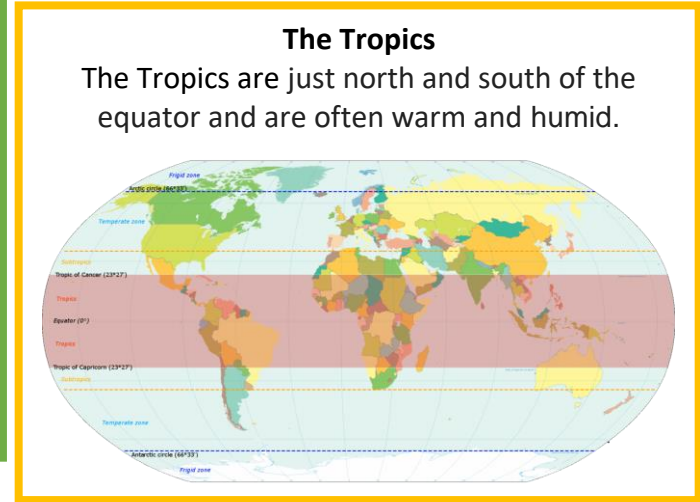




**Vocabulary**

<b>Channel Islands</b>	The channel Islands are in the English Channel between England and France.
<b>Country</b>	The land where there are people.
<b>County</b>	The main areas of a country.
<b>Factory</b>	A large building where machines are used to make things.
<b>Harvest</b>	The time when farmers gather in the corn, fruit or vegetables they have grown.
<b>Import</b>	Bring in goods from another country.
<b>Industry</b>	Making or producing goods.
<b>Landscape</b>	A picture of the countryside.
<b>Local</b>	A particular place or small area.
<b>Pasture</b>	Land covered with grass that cattle, sheep or horses can eat.
<b>Temperature</b>	How hot or cold a person, place or thing is.
<b>Tropical</b>	To do with the tropics.
