The world is a precious treasure and God wants us to take care of it.

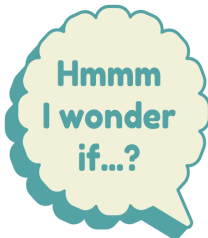


Psalms is a book in the Bible full of poems, prayers and songs. Some psalms give praise to God for making our wonderful world.
