Half Termly Learning overview: Summer 1

Year: 6

This is a summary of the learning taking place for the half term beginning: 14 04 26.

Not every subject listed is taught every week.

Subject		Learning
English	Reading	SATs reading resources will be used to develop accurate reading at the correct pace. The children will also use the texts to improve comprehension and vocabulary development. Class readers: Windrush Child and Goodnight, Mister Tom
	Writing	We will revise punctuation and grammar to support our writing, consolidating, and building on prior knowledge. Report writing: the children will develop their learning about no-fiction writing, completing a report on The Windrush Generation.
Maths		The children will complete topic work on shape. They will then revise several areas in preparation for SATs tests.
Religious Education		Children will learn about the disciples' responses to The Resurrection. We will explore the spread of the new religion of Christianity after Jesus's Resurrection. We will reflect on God's call to us to be true disciples of Jesus.
Science		The class will learn about evolution and inheritance. They will learn about important scientists in the advance of evolutionary thinking and how genes affect our development.
Geography		Children will compare various UK local economies and settlements, investigating land use and economic relationships. They will look for patterns in developments, how this links to physical geography such as rivers and consider what causes settlements to decline.
PSHE		Weekly topics covered will focus on the themes of healthy habits, vaccinations, Holocaust, and children's mental health. The children will be encouraged to reflect on these and link these to their own lives.
Primary Languages- French (KS2 only)		The children will introduce themselves to their next French teacher by preparing their French transition project, ready for sending on to their new secondary school.
Art & Design		The children will explore creative ways to make memories, they will investigate sculpture, 3D relief and analyse the concept of self.
Computing		The children will develop their speed with keyboard skills, learning how to type text quickly whilst developing consistent accuracy.
Music		The class will study a piece of music from the film 'Chariots of Fire.' They will create music to accompany a short film about a race, composing an extended melody and accompaniment
PE		OAA- we will play games linked to team building and co-operation skill development. Striking and Fielding – cricket and rounders
