Half Termly Learning overview: Summer 1

Year: 3

This is a summary of the learning and taking place for the half term beginning: 14th April 2026

Not every subject listed is taught every week.

Subject		Learning
English	Reading	In Guided Reading, the children will be looking at a variety of text types.
	Writing	The children will be exploring how to write a wishing story (myth). They will learn a model text with actions and then they will innovate their own story. They will also look closely at the grammatical features that are used in a wishing story.
Maths		Fractions B – Pupils will learn to solve calculations involving fractions and finding fractions of quantities. With money, they will learn to convert money and solve calculations, including finding change. In time, they will tell the time to the nearest minute.
Religious Education		In this branch, pupils will look at how Mass today mirrors Mass celebrated by the first disciples. They will also begin to explore the mystery of the Holy Trinity in more depth, though as it is a mystery, it is not something that can be explained or understood.
Science		Children will be exploring Light – explaining how light enables to see objects, how shadows are formed and how the size and shape of a shadow is affected by various factors.
History		The children will be completing their topic about the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain. They will look at the difference that the Romanisation of Britain made. There will also be a dedicated Romans Day on Friday 2 nd May.
Geography		In Geography, the children will be learning about OS maps and scale - explaining the difference between small- and large-scale maps. They will also be using a range of local maps to identify human and natural features.
PSHE		Through class discussions and activities, the children will be exploring feelings and emotions. They will also be exploring personal safety.
Primary Languages- French (KS2 only)		The children will learn to name days of the week, months and seasons so they can recognise and tell the date in French.
Art & Design inc Design Technology		Developing Drawing Skills - Developing shading skills and drawing techniques to create botanical-inspired digital drawings.
Computing		We are Network Engineers – The children will be learning how computers networks work and how networks are made secure.
Music		In the unit Just Three Notes – the children will invent simple patterns using rhythms and notes C-D-E. In the unit Samba with Sérgio, the children will move in time with the beat of the music and perform call-and-response rhythms vocally.
PE		Indoor – Gymnastics – Hand Apparatus Outdoor – Outdoor Adventurous Activities
