Dear Parent/Carers,

The school Summer Fete is returning on Saturday 4th July 12-3pm and Year 6 pupils have been busy planning stalls to run at the event. Many of you will remember the fun games and activities year 6 pupils came up in previous years, and we are sure this year's year 6 pupils will rise to the challenge and bring us even more excitement at the 2026 fete!

Your child will be planning their stall in a group, so will not have to be on the stall for the whole 3 hours, and will be able to go and explore the other activities too.
