We have sent the passwords for Mathletics and Numbots home with all children this week. So you should have all received them in your child's book bag. We have set activities on there for your child to practise.

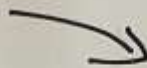

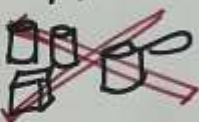
