



Can you make an under the sea picture? Make your paper wet and paint strips of blues and greens across the paper to make a background. When this is dry, you can build other parts of the picture on top.



Sprinkling salt on your wet paint, leaving it to dry and then shaking it off, makes interesting marks .



Or you can tear paper in strips to make waves.



Curling paper and sticking at both ends but bending it in between makes a 3D effect.



You might prefer to cut pieces of paper in different shapes to make a mosaic style picture.
You could use pages from a magazine with the right colours.



If you have bubble wrap - printing with or painting onto this makes some interesting patterns too.



This effect is created by sticking some bubble wrap to a cardboard tube and rolling it across the paper.



You could make a fish in the same way.



Maybe add some other
sea creatures!
