Key facts

Jesus was taken back to heaven to be with God the Father.

Jesus made a promise that He would always be with the disciples and that God would send the Holy Spirit.

On the day of the Jewish festival of Pentecost God sent the Holy Spirit to the disciples.

They could then speak bravely to people about Jesus, even in Lots of different languages.

Key vocabulary

ascend – to go up

reaction – to behave in a particular way according to what has happened

promise - to say that something will definitely happen

Holy Spirit – a part of God (one of the Holy Trinity – God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit) God's powerful helper
