## Key Vocabulary

*Eucharist* - another word for the Mass; it comes from the Greek word meaning to give thanks.

*Holy Communion* - The bread and wine that has been changed into the body and blood of Jesus, which we receive at Mass

*Blessed Sacrament* - the body and blood of our Lord in the form of bread and wine

Genuflect - to go down on the right knee as a sign of reverence, for example before the tabernacle in Church

*Gospel* - this means Good News and is the story of the life of Jesus

*Saviour* - A name given to Jesus, because he died and rose
