The resurrection of Jesus turned Jesus' disciples from		
cowards into heroes. However it was not until they		
received the Holy Spirit that they were truly changed into		
courageous men.		
Every male Jew within 20 mile radius of Jerusalem was		
obliged to go to Jerusalem for the feast of Pentecost.		
This feast commemorated the giving of the Jewish Law, the		
Torah, including the Ten Commandments, to Moses.		
"Brother Saul, the Lord—Jesus, who appeared to you on		
the road as you were coming here—has sent me so that		
you may see again and be filled with the Holy		
Spirit." 18 Immediately, something like scales fell from		
Saul's eyes, and he could see again. He was then known as		
Paul.
