



Catechism of the Catholic Church
<p>Christ sent forth the apostles he had chosen, commissioning them to proclaim the Gospel: <b><i>‘Go forth and make disciples of all nations, baptizing then in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you, I am with you always, to the close of the age.’</i></b></p> <p>Strengthened by this mission, the apostles went forth and preached everywhere, while the Lord worked with them and confirmed the message by the signs that attended it.</p>

Key Facts
The resurrection of Jesus turned Jesus’ disciples from cowards into heroes. However it was not until they received the Holy Spirit that they were truly changed into courageous men.
Every male Jew within 20 mile radius of Jerusalem was obliged to go to Jerusalem for the feast of Pentecost.
This feast commemorated the giving of the Jewish Law, the Torah, including the Ten Commandments, to Moses.
<b><i>“Brother Saul, the Lord—Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you were coming here—has sent me so that you may see again and be filled with the Holy Spirit.”</i></b> <sup>18</sup> Immediately, something like scales fell from Saul’s eyes, and he could see again. He was then known as Paul.

Key Vocabulary	
<b>Apostle</b>	One sent to preach the Gospel, one of the twelve disciples of Christ.
<b>Persecution</b>	To harass, hunt down or possibly put to death for religious or political opinions.
<b>Preaching</b>	A public religious service with a sermon
<b>Pentecost</b>	A Christian festival celebrated on the seventh Sunday after Easter, commemorating the descent of the Holy Ghost upon the apostles; Whitsunday.
<b>Holy Spirit</b>	The spirit of God
<b>Miracle</b>	An effect or event manifesting or considered as a work of God
<b>Confirmation</b>	When a member of the Church receives that Holy Spirit
<b>Imitate</b>	To copy and follow an example
<b>Repent</b>	To feel such sorrow for sin or fault to be disposed to change one's life for the better; be penitent
<b>Prophet</b>	A person who speaks for God.
<b>Transform</b>	To change
