Subject		Learning
English	Reading	Class texts- The Enchanted Wood, The Magic Faraway Tree and The Folk Of The Faraway Tree. Class author boxes- Michael Rosen, David McKee, Julia Donaldson and Alan Ahlberg
	Writing	Handas Surprise by Eileen Browne. Learn the text and then innovate this to create a new version. Grammar focus – sentence punctuation including capital letter, full stop, question mark and exclamation mark.
Maths		Place value to 100- counting, partitioning numbers into tens and ones and comparing numbers using vocabulary more and less, greater and fewer. Measure – Focus on time to the hour and half past as well as recognising coins
Religious Education		Reading and discuss the parables ' The Storm At Sea ' and ' The Cure Of The Paralysed Man. ' Discuss as a class how Jesus can help us when we feel afraid and how to thank God in prayer for people who help us in our community.
Science		Animals Including Humans Revisit- What features do animals have? What are the features of mammals, birds, amphibians and reptiles? What senses do I have? We will have a police dog visiting us and will be learning about how he uses his senses.
History		More Lives of Significant People- Who was Neil Armstrong? Tim Peake? Mae Jemison? What did they each achieve? Revisit Changes in Living Memory- What are the stages in my life? What are toys and how can we sort them? How have toys changes since I was a baby?
Geography		This is not covered this half term
PSHE		Journey in Love- To recognise signs that you are loved in your family and how we meet Gods love in our families. In discussion we will cover how we are cared for and looked after by our families.
Art & Design inc Design Technology		DT: Textiles – Making Puppets. Explore different ways of joining fabrics before creating hand puppets based upon characters from a well-known fairy tale. Develop technical skills of cutting, gluing, stapling and pinning.
Computing		We are collectors Finding and using images using the web. Resizing images to a scale.
Music		'Reflect Rewind and Replay' This Unit of Work consolidates the learning that has occurred during the year. There will be a revisit of the music covered this year through songs, instruments and class
PE		Athletics- running jumping and throwing skills. Sports day – taking part in races and being part of a team.
