Half Termly Learning overview:

Year: Three

This is a summary of the learning and taking place for the half term beginning: 3rd June 2024

Not every subject listed is taught every week.

Subject		Learning
English	Reading	The children's class read this half-term will be 'Esio Trot' by Roald Dahl. In guided reading, they will be looking at a variety of text types such as narrative and non-fiction. The children will also be carrying out 15 minutes of independent daily reading.
	Writing	The children will be doing a book study of 'The invention of Hugo Cabret' and creating their own work based on this. Then children will also be rehearsing and refining a range of grammatical features related to this text type. Through this narrative text type the children will be answering questions about the characters in the story and the events that happen. They will be making inferences about what might happen next and how characters might behave and feel as well as learning new vocabulary.
Maths		The children will be strengthening their time-telling skills and learning Roman Numerals. They will be learning about statistics (collecting and analysing information) and 2D and 3D shapes.
Religious Education		The children will be continuing their learning on 'A Journey of love' where they will be exploring more about relationships and how they can grow in love in caring and happy friendships where we they are secure and safe.
Science		The children will be re-visiting their learning about Rocks. They will be discovering more about the different types of rocks that can be found and how they can change and how fossils are formed. They will also be learning more about the different layers of the Earth.
History		The focus this term is Geography.
Geography		The children will be learning about Megacities which are cities that contain more than 10 million people. They will be comparing different megacities and looking at the differences and similarities.
Music		Music: To discuss music genres, focussing on Reggae and Disco. Children will listen and appraise examples, improvise and compose using provided notes. There will play percussion and tuned instruments including glockenspiels and recorders.
Primary Languages- French (KS2 only)		The children will learn to describe their family and to express opinions about food items.
Art & Design inc Design Technology		Mechanisms: Making a moving monster. After learning the terms: pivot, lever and linkage, pupils will design a monster that will move using a linkage mechanism. Pupils practise making linkages and experiment with various materials to bring their monsters to life.
Computing		Computers: To design surveys, collect data and present findings through a range of different graphs.
PE		The children will be preparing for Sport's Day in June and then continue to practise dance moves on the theme of Machines. The children will continue to attend swimming lessons and improving their swimming skills.
