Dear Parents

What a great start to Year 2 we have had! It has been wonderful getting to know the children in 2D and 2R over the last few days.

We just wanted to inform you of our plans for PE and Forest School so you are aware of our routines and clothing requirements. **Both PE and Forest School sessions will begin next week** (week beginning 8th September).

P.E.

Year 2 will have their **PE session on Fridays**. This means that the children should come to school dressed in their PE kit on Fridays and they will wear this **all** day and then go home in their PE kit so there will be **no changing** at school. Lessons will be in the hall and outside so please ensure that they are ready for all weathers.

Depending on the weather the school PE uniform should include:

- Trainers
- School t-shirt or plain white t-shirt
- Navy shorts
- Plain black or navy joggers
- School hoodie or plain navy hoodie

All PE uniform should be plain with no logos, unless it is the school logo. If your child wears earrings please ensure they are taken out **before** coming to school on a Friday.

Forest School

Our Forest School sessions will be on Tuesdays and led by Mrs Lloyd. The children **should come to school dressed in Forest School clothes**. These should be clothes that children will not mind getting wet or muddy in! We strongly recommend **trousers, a long sleeved top, waterproof trousers, waterproof coat, jumper, and hats and gloves** for when the weather turns cooler. In addition to this, please can children also have spare trousers/leggings and top to change into should their Forest School clothes get too dirty to wear inside school, and their wellies in a bag to change into for their session. Long hair should be tied up and **earrings removed**.
